"30 Something"

Challenge

- Create a quilt or quilted item using your interpretation of the number "30"

Your entry can be in the following categories

1. Functional quilt, no minimum size, maximum size, Lap/throw, approx 50 x 60
2. Art quilt, no minimum size, max size 50 x 60
3. Quilted "Object" such as dolls, handbags, apparel or home decor

Voting

- Viewers Choice in each category. Items will be displayed to the membership in May 2021, method to be announced. Recognition will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each category.

Rules

- Entry can be by individual member or a group (2 or more) of Guild members
- Entry should be a finished piece, ready to display or give away. No quilt tops please.
- Construction can be any method: traditional piecing, appliqué, Paper-piecing, embroidery, collage, by hand or machine or both....going wild is allowed!
- Attach a folded paper tag to the item. Indicate the category you are entering, your name and any group members as well as a brief description of your theme representation

Some inspiration

- 30th anniversary traditions :
 - gem stones are Pearl (Traditional) and Diamond (Modern)
 - colour is green
 - flower is the lily
- Turning 30 years of age
- a quilt with 30 blocks, 30 colours or 30 shades (of green?)
- 30 degrees above/below zero
- 30 degrees starboard, 30 kp/h
- 30% off (a quilter's delight)
